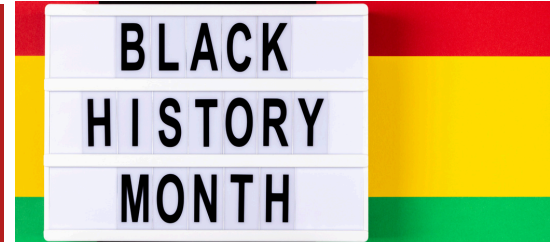




Why Choose AFC Urgent Care Instead of the ER?
